- (b) (1) The Committee consists of 9 members.
 - (2) Of the 9 members of the Committee:
 - (i) 3 shall represent employees;
 - (ii) 3 shall represent employers; and
 - (iii) 3 shall be disinterested individuals from the general public.
- (3) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, the Committee membership shall be apportioned geographically over the State.
- (4) The Secretary of Licensing and Regulation shall appoint the members with the approval of the Governor.
- (c) Before taking office, each appointee to the Committee shall take the oath required by Article I, § 9 of the Maryland Constitution.
 - (d) (1) The term of a member is 6 years and begins on July 1.
- (2) The terms of members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Committee on October 1, 1991.
- (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
 - (e) The Governor may remove a member for incompetence or misconduct.
- (f) From among the members from the general public, the Secretary of Licensing and Regulation shall appoint a chairman.]

- [(a)] In addition to any regulation specifically required by this subtitle, regulations that the Commissioner adopts to carry out this subtitle may include:
- (1) definitions of the terms "administrative capacity", "executive capacity", "professional capacity", and "outside salesman";
- (2) a scale of wages that is suitable for learners and apprentices but is at least 80% of the minimum wage under this subtitle; and
- (3) a wage for a special case or class of case if the Commissioner finds the wage appropriate to:
 - (i) avoid undue hardship;
 - (ii) prevent the curtailment of employment opportunity; and
 - (iii) safeguard the minimum wage under this subtitle.
