SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 49D - Office for Children, Youth, and Families

[3.

- (a) The Advisory Committee is a part of the Office for Children, Youth, and Families and exercises the powers and duties specified in this section.
 - (b) The Governor shall appoint an Advisory Committee which shall consist of:
 - (1) One representative from each children's council, a total of 24;
 - (2) 12 members appointed from the general public; and
- (3) Representatives from the Departments of Education, Health and Mental Hygiene, Human Resources, and Juvenile Services.
- (c) The terms of members are staggered as required by the terms of members serving on July 1, 1983.
 - (d) Members are appointed for a term of 3 years.
- (e) The Governor annually shall designate 1 of the members to serve as chairman of the Advisory Committee.
- (f) In the event of the resignation of a member or a vacancy in the membership of the Advisory Committee for any reason, the Governor shall appoint a qualified person to fill the unexpired term of the member.
