- 2. if a Delegate simultaneously serves in 2 of the positions set forth in items (ii) through [(ix)] (VIII), inclusive, of this paragraph, [4] 5 other Delegates, appointed by the Speaker and approved by majority vote of the House.
- (b) (1) As far as possible, the Senators appointed by the President, under subsection (a)(1)(ix) of this section, shall be representative of the various sections and interests of the State.
- (2) As far as possible, the Delegates appointed by the Speaker, under subsection (a)(2) [(xi)] (X) of this section, shall be representative of the various sections and interests of the State.
