AN ACT concerning

Prince George's County - Energy Tax

PG 413-93

FOR the purpose of repealing prohibiting the County Council for Prince George's County from imposing, by ordinance, and collecting a sales or use tax on any form of energy or fuel used in Prince George's County in a percentage greater than the percentage in effect on July 1, 1992; and extending a certain termination date for the Prince George's County energy tax.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions

9-603.

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the County Council for Prince George's County may impose, by ordinance, and collect, IN A PERCENTAGE NO GREATER THAN THE PERCENTAGE IN EFFECT ON JULY 1, 1992, a sales or use tax on any form of energy or fuel used in Prince George's County.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1987. It shall remain effective for a period of 6 g years and, at the end of June 30, 1995, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1993.
