SECTION 9. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the authority to borrow money and issue bonds conferred on the County by this Act shall be deemed to provide additional, alternative and supplemental authority for borrowing money and shall be regarded as supplemental and additional to powers conferred upon the County by other laws and may not be regarded as in derogation of any power now existing; and allipreviously enacted laws authorizing the County to borrow money are hereby continued to the extent that the power contained in them is continuing or has not been exercised, unless any law is expressly repealed by this Act, and the validity of any bonds issued under previously enacted laws is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved. This Act, being necessary for the welfare of the inhabitants of the County, shall be liberally construed to effect its purposes. All Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed to the extent of any inconsistency.

SECTION 10. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1993.

CHAPTER 582

(House Bill 1032)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Tow Trucks - Registration

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from operating, for hire, a tow truck that is required to be registered in the State but is not registered as a tow truck under a certain provision of law; establishing a certain penalty; prohibiting a police department from authorizing a person to use a tow truck for certain purposes related to the removal and storage of abandoned vehicles unless the tow truck is registered as a tow truck; requiring a person registering a tow truck to provide certain information; and generally relating to the registration of tow trucks.
