- (A) (1) THE EMS BOARD CONSISTS OF 11 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.
  - (2) OF THE 11 MEMBERS:
- (I) ONE SHALL BE THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE:
- (II) ONE SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND AT BALTIMORE. NOMINATED BY THE BOARD OF REGENTS:
- (III) ONE SHALL BE THE CHAIRMAN CHAIRPERSON OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL:
- (IV) ONE SHALL BE A PHYSICIAN KNOWLEDGEABLE IN THE DELIVERY OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES;
- (V) ONE SHALL BE A PHYSICIAN EXPERIENCED IN THE CLINICAL CARE OF TRAUMA PATIENTS;
- $\,$  (VI)  $\,$  ONE SHALL BE A NURSE EXPERIENCED IN THE CLINICAL CARE OF EMERGENCY PATIENTS;
- (VII) ONE SHALL BE A FIRE FIGHTER/PARAMEDIC CAREER FIRE FIGHTER, EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN, OR RESCUE SQUADMAN SQUAD PERSON KNOWLEDGEABLE IN THE DELIVERY OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES;
- (VIII) ONE SHALL BE A VOLUNTEER FIRE FIGHTER, EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN, OR RESCUE SQUADMAN SQUAD PERSON KNOWLEDGEABLE IN THE DELIVERY OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES;
- (VIII) (IX) ONE SHALL BE A HOSPITAL ADMINISTRATOR KNOWLEDGEABLE IN THE MANAGEMENT AND DELIVERY OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES; AND
  - (IX) THREE SHALL BE FROM THE PUBLIC AT LARGE.
- (X) TWO SHALL BE FROM THE PUBLIC AT LARGE, ONE OF WHOM SHALL RESIDE IN A COUNTY WITH A POPULATION OF LESS THAN 175,000.
- (B) (1) EACH APPOINTED MEMBER SHALL HAVE DEMONSTRATED INTEREST OR EXPERIENCE IN THE DELIVERY OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES
- (2) IN APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE EMS BOARD, THE GOVERNOR SHALL TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION THE FIVE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE REGIONS OF THE STATE TO ASSURE A GEOGRAPHIC BALANCE IN THE BOARD'S MEMBERSHIP.
