- (A) (1) A MAJORITY OF THE FULL AUTHORIZED MEMBERSHIP OF THE EMS BOARD IS A OUORUM FOR THE TRANSACTION OF ANY BUSINESS.
- (2) THE EMS BOARD MAY ADOPT ANY RULES OR PROCEDURES NECESSARY TO ENSURE THE ORDERLY CONDUCT OF BUSINESS.
- (B) NO FORMAL ACTION MAY BE TAKEN BY THE EMS BOARD WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF A MAJORITY OF THE FULL AUTHORIZED MEMBERSHIP OF THE EMS BOARD.
- (B) (C) THE EMS BOARD SHALL MEET AT LEAST SIX TIMES A YEAR, AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT IT DETERMINES.
- (C) (D) EACH MEMBER OF THE EMS BOARD IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
- (A) IN ADDITION TO THE POWERS SET FORTH ELSEWHERE IN THIS SUBTITLE, THE EMS BOARD MAY:
