SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Health Occupations**

~~(2) The fees charged shall be set so as to produce funds to approximate the cost of maintaining the Board [and contributing to the General Fund of the State as provided in subsection (d) of this section].~~

~~(d) (1) The Board shall pay all fees collected under the provisions of this title to the Comptroller of the State.~~

~~(2) The Comptroller shall distribute:~~

~~(i) 20 percent of the fees received from the Board to the General Fund of the State; and~~
