In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 326.

This bill would eliminate the requirement that a county, municipality, or special taxing district impose a minimum \$1 per capita tax levy and file certifications of such levies as a condition for the receipt of individual income tax revenue and highway user revenue.

House Bill 722, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 11, 1993, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 326.
