and shall issue to the Governor and General Assembly a report on his findings by December 15, 1993. The findings shall include consideration of all operational aspects of a Family Division, including the costs associated with and essential to the efficient operation of a Family Division.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals, when establishing a Family Division in a circuit court, may provide for the continuance of the use of domestic relations masters in those courts where domestic relations masters currently exist.

SECTION 8. 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That subject to the provisions of Section 7 above, this Act shall take effect July 1, 1995 October 1, 1993.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 342.
