FOR the purpose of requiring that the ~~Child Support Enforcement Administration's central registry of records interface with Maryland State Police to receive, accept, and incorporate civil child support warrants in the Maryland Interagency Law Enforcement System (MILES); requiring that the Child Support Enforcement Administration and the State Police to cooperate in the implementation of this system with local child support enforcement offices and law enforcement agencies; requiring that certain court orders be included in the central registry of records; authorizing any a law enforcement agency or officer to access the MILES system System for a certain purpose; establishing certain responsibilities of local child support offices and law enforcement agencies; defining certain terms; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to interfacing computer systems to enforce orders the entry of certain child support warrants in the MILES computer system Maryland Interagency Law Enforcement System.~~
