(h) (1) [In] THE Anne Arundel County [the] Board of License Commissioners [is authorized to approve the] MAY issue [of] a license[,] to be known as a resort complex license, covering "on-sales" of beer, wine and liquor to any person, for the sale of any and all alcoholic beverages within the confines of the resort complex. This license shall be issued only to the person, firm, or corporation owning or leasing a resort complex. Resort complex shall mean for the purpose of this section a recreational area of ten (10) or more acres with beach facilities and facilities to serve and accommodate five hundred (500) or more persons at one time.

(2) The cost for this license is fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) each year, to be paid [the first of May, payable to the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel County] ON MAY 1 TO THE BOARD and entitles the holder to sell at one or more locations within the resort complex on each and every day and permits playing of music and dancing and no provision contained in subsection (a) of this section relating to special Sunday licenses applies to the holder of a license issued under [the provisions of] this subsection.

(3) The licenses and the licensees hereunder are subject to all laws, rules and regulations applicable in Anne Arundel County to the sale of alcoholic beverages, not inconsistent with the provisions of this subsection. This license permits the sale at bars or counters, but not for consumption off the premises. Licensees may serve alcoholic beverages at one or more outside locations within the resort complex from 8 a.m. to 12 midnight for each outing and from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. in main, permanent areas.

(i) (1) [In] THE Anne Arundel County [the] Board of License Commissioners [is authorized to approve the] MAY issue [of] a license[,] to be known as a motel-restaurant complex or hotel-restaurant complex license, covering "on-sales" of beer, wine and liquor to any person, without further residential, voting or locative qualifications being required of the applicant, for the sale of any and all alcoholic beverages within the confines of the motel-restaurant complex or hotel-restaurant complex. These licenses shall be issued only to the person, firm, or corporation owning or leasing motel-restaurant complexes or hotel-restaurant complexes that have a capital investment of not less than \$500,000, 100 rooms or more, and an enclosed dining room which serves full-course meals from menus at least twice daily. If the food concession is leased to a concessionaire, the concessionaire is exempt from having a capital investment of not less than \$500,000. Any motel-restaurant complex or hotel-restaurant complex with 100 or more rooms shall have a motel-restaurant or hotel-restaurant complex license by October 1, 1977.

(2) The cost of this license for each separate establishment is \$3,000 each year, to be paid on May 1 to the [Clerk of the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel County] BOARD and entitles the holder to sell at one or more locations within the hotel-restaurant or motel-restaurant complex on each and every day and permits playing of music and dancing and no provision contained in subsection (a) of this section relating to special Sunday licenses applies to the holder of a license issued under [the provisions of] this subsection.
