

of the State of Maryland and for continuing participation in the State Employee and Retiree Health and Welfare Benefits Program, including certain health benefits on retirement; requiring the Service to make certain payments for retirement and health benefits in a certain manner and subject to certain penalties; repealing provisions related to the Service Reserve Fund; amending the authority of the Service to enter into contracts and agreements; clarifying and amending the powers and organization of the Service; authorizing the Service to take certain corporate actions; amending the authority of the Secretary of the Environment to require the Service to operate wastewater and solid waste projects; amending the procedures by which service regions and service districts are created; requiring the Service to make certain reports to the Governor and General Assembly and submit certain budget information to the General Assembly; providing that the books, records, and accounts of the Service are subject to audit by the State, including the Legislative Auditor; providing for the effective date of this Act; and generally relating to the Maryland Environmental Service.
