SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the subheading designation “Abortion” in Article 27 – Crimes and Punishments of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 4 and 5, respectively, of Article 27 – Crimes and Punishments – of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 3 and 4, respectively.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 27 – Crimes and Punishments**
