

THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR, THE FEES SHALL NOT REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE, BUT INSTEAD SHALL BE MAINTAINED AS SPECIAL FUNDS AVAILABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR CARRYING OUT THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(2) THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT CHARGE A FEE TO A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY TO COVER OR SUPPORT THE ONGOING MAINTENANCE OR UPKEEP OF THE DATA BASE.

(C) A LOCAL JURISDICTION SHALL FURNISH TO THE DEPARTMENT:

(1) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 1993, A COPY OF ITS DULY ADOPTED LOCAL FIRE CODE; AND

(2) WITHIN 15 DAYS OF ITS EFFECTIVE DATE, ANY AMENDMENT TO THE LOCAL FIRE CODE.

6-405.

(A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:

(1) COORDINATE WITH LOCAL BUILDING OFFICIALS, THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL'S OFFICE, AND LOCAL FIRE OFFICIALS IN COMPILING INFORMATION FOR THE CENTRAL DATA BASE ESTABLISHED UNDER § 6-404 OF THIS SUBTITLE;

(2) NOTIFY LOCAL JURISDICTIONS OF CHANGES TO THE BOCA NATIONAL BUILDING CODE AND THE IMPACT SUCH CHANGES WILL HAVE ON THE LOCAL AMENDMENTS IN EACH LOCAL JURISDICTION;

(3) INCLUDE IN THE CENTRAL DATA BASE PROPOSED STATE OR FEDERAL LEGISLATION OF WHICH THE DEPARTMENT IS AWARE AND THAT DIRECTLY AFFECTS THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY;

(4) IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MARYLAND BUILDING OFFICIALS ASSOCIATION AND OTHER INTERESTED ORGANIZATIONS, PROVIDE TRAINING FOR LOCAL BUILDING OFFICIALS ON THE MARYLAND BUILDING PERFORMANCE STANDARDS AND CERTIFY THE PARTICIPATION OF LOCAL BUILDING OFFICIALS IN THE TRAINING; AND

(5) ON REQUEST, PROVIDE LOCAL JURISDICTIONS WITH TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE CONCERNING THE IMPLEMENTATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF THE MARYLAND BUILDING PERFORMANCE STANDARDS.

(B) THE DEPARTMENT MAY:

(1) COMPILE AND INCLUDE IN THE CENTRAL DATA BASE ESTABLISHED UNDER § 6-404(A) OF THIS SUBTITLE:

(I) ANY INFORMATION PROVIDED BY LOCAL JURISDICTIONS ON THE IMPLEMENTATION AND INTERPRETATION OF THE MARYLAND BUILDING PERFORMANCE STANDARDS BY LOCAL JURISDICTIONS; AND
