In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 1310.

This bill would remove the June 30, 1993 sunset provision on Chapter 302 of 1991, which requires the Registers of Wills to make available a Probate Information Booklet for a \$2 fee.

Senate Bill 790, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on April 13, 1993, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 1310.

**House Bill No. 1310**

AN ACT concerning

**Estates and Trusts – Probate Information Booklets – Removal of Termination Provision**

FOR the purpose of removing the termination provision from the law authorizing registers of wills to provide to the public, an information booklet and materials on probate matters; and providing for the effective date of this Act.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
Chapter 302 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1991  
Section 2

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Chapter 302 of the Acts of 1991**

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991. [It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June 30, 1993, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1993.
