This bill would decrease the motor fuel tax rate for clean-burning fuels to 23.5 cents per gallon.

Senate Bill 775, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 11, 1993, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 1324.
