Laws of Montgomery County, 1992

AN ACT to:

- (1) change the goal of the productivity housing program;
- (2) extend the existence of the Productivity Housing Advisory Committee until a certain date and provide for certain appointments or reappointments to the Committee;
- (3) extend the authority of the Director of the Department of Housing and Community Development to execute a preliminary agreement for productivity housing until a certain date; and
- (4) generally amend the productivity housing law.
