AN ACT concerning

**Human Relations Code**

FOR the purpose of clarifying certain provisions of the Code relating to discrimination in housing and residential real estate transactions; amending certain provisions concerning the filing of complaints and conciliation agreements; prohibiting discrimination in the brokering, listing and appraisal of residential real estate; removing references to certain design and construction of new multi-family dwellings which are fully enforced under the Building Code; amending certain exemptions regarding discrimination on age and familial status; amending certain monetary remedies; and generally relating to fair housing provisions.
