

(4) What actions the State Board of Education will take upon failure of the school to meet the requirements set by the school improvement plan in the time allotted.

(5) Whether or not the State Board will order the school to close and under what circumstances the school may be reopened and operated.

It is the intent of the General Assembly that the proposed bylaws be presented to the committees of the General Assembly which oversee local education aid at the same time they are presented to the Administrative, Executive, Legislative Review Committee. The budget committees and House Committee on Ways and Means should be allowed to review and comment on the bylaws before they are finalized.
