AN EMERGENCY BILL TO REPEAL AND RE-ENACT TITLE 20 OF THE TALBOT COUNTY CODE, ESTABLISHING FLOODPLAIN ZONES WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF TALBOT COUNTY, MARYLAND AND REQUIRING A PERMIT FOR ALL DEVELOPMENT WITHIN THE DESIGNATED FLOODPLAIN ZONE; PROVIDING CERTAIN MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR CONSTRUCTION WITHIN THE FLOODPLAIN ZONE; SETTING FORTH STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES FOR SUBMISSION AND APPROVAL OF PLANS FOR DEVELOPMENT; AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.
