SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

6.

(a) (1) The following classes of wholesaler's licenses shall be issued at the designated annual fees:

Class 1 Beer, wine and liquor	Annual fee — \$2,000
Class 2 Wine and liquor	Annual fee — 1,750
Class 3 Beer and wine	Annual fee — 1,500
Class 4 Beer	Annual fee — 1,250
Class 5 Wine	Δnnual fee — 1 250

- (2) Upon approval of application:
- (I) A Class 1 wholesale licensee shall be entitled to use additional locations for the warehousing, sale and delivery of beer, wine and liquor upon the payment of an additional fee of \$2,000 for each additional location.
- (II) A Class 2 wholesale licensee shall be entitled to use additional locations for the warehousing, sale and delivery of wine and liquor upon the payment of an additional fee of \$1.750 for each additional location.
- (III) A Class 3 wholesale licensee shall be entitled to use additional locations for the warehousing, sale and delivery of beer and wine upon the payment of an additional fee of \$1,500 for each additional location.
- (IV) A Class 4 wholesale licensee shall be entitled to use additional locations for the warehousing, sale and delivery of beer upon the payment of an additional fee of \$1,250 for each additional location.
- (V) A Class 5 wholesale licensee shall be entitled to use additional locations for the warehousing, sale and delivery of wine upon the payment OF an additional fee of \$1,250 for each additional location.
- (3) Two locations under one license [shall] MAY not be located in any one county or in Baltimore City.
