7-206. SAME — FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES IN EXECUTIVE PAY PLAN.

- (A) SCOPE OF SECTION.
- (1) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO EMPLOYEES WHO ARE INCLUDED IN THE EXECUTIVE PAY PLAN AT A PAY GRADE OF (ES) 6 OR ABOVE.
- (2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO COMPENSATORY TIME EARNED ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30, 1989.
 - (B) LIMITS ON ACCRUAL.

ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 1989, AN EMPLOYEE SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION MAY NOT ACCRUE ANY COMPENSATORY TIME OTHER THAN FOR WORK ON A HOLIDAY AND ONLY IF THE EMPLOYEE WORKS 5 OR MORE HOURS ON THE HOLIDAY.

(C) AMOUNT OF COMPENSATORY TIME.

AN EMPLOYEE SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION ACCRUES 1 WORKDAY OF COMPENSATORY TIME FOR EACH HOLIDAY ON WHICH THE EMPLOYEE WORKS 5 HOURS OR MORE.

(D) WHEN LEAVE MUST BE USED.

AN EMPLOYEE MUST USE ANY COMPENSATORY TIME ACCRUED UNDER THIS SECTION WITHIN 1 YEAR AFTER-HAVING ACCRUED THAT TIME.

SUBTITLE 3. ANNUAL LEAVE.

7-301. SCOPE OF SUBTITLE.

THIS SUBTITLE APPLIES TO:

- (1) ALL CLASSIFIED SERVICE AND UNCLASSIFIED SERVICE EMPLOYEES IN THE STATE PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM; AND
- (2) ALL EMPLOYEES IN THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT WHO ARE APPOINTED OFFICIALS.
