8-108. SAME — RETIREES.

(A) DEFINITIONS.

(1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "CREDITABLE SERVICE" MEANS:

(I) SERVICE CREDITED TOWARD A RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE UNDER ARTICLE 73B OF THE CODE; OR

(II) SERVICE AS A JUDGE, AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 73B, § 9-101 OF THE CODE.

(3) (I) "RETIREE" MEANS:

1. A FORMER STATE EMPLOYEE WHO RECEIVES A RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE UNDER ARTICLE 73B OF THE CODE; OR

2. A FORMER EMPLOYEE OF THE MEDICAL SYSTEM CORPORATION, AS DEFINED IN § 13-1B-01 OR § 13-1C-01 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE, WHO RECEIVES A RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE FROM THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND OR THE PENSION SYSTEM FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND UNDER TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 1 OF ARTICLE 73B OF THE CODE.

(II) "RETIREE" DOES NOT INCLUDE:

1. A MEMBER OF THE FACULTY OR STAFF OF A COMMUNITY COLLEGE;

2. A TEACHER OR A STAFF MEMBER EMPLOYED BY A COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION; OR

3. AN INDIVIDUAL WHO RETIRED UNDER AN OPTIONAL PROGRAM UNDER TITLE 11 OF ARTICLE 73B OF THE CODE.

(4) "STATE SERVICE" MEANS SERVICE WITH THIS STATE BY:

(I) AN EMPLOYEE, AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 73B, § 2-101 OR § 4-101 OF THE CODE;

(II) A JUDGE, AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 73B, § 9-101 OF THE CODE;
