(2) ANY OTHER POLICY OR REGULATION OVER WHICH MANAGEMENT HAS CONTROL.

10-102. SCOPE OF TITLE.

(A) IN GENERAL.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW, THIS TITLE APPLIES TO ALL CLASSIFIED SERVICE AND UNCLASSIFIED SERVICE EMPLOYEES OF ANY UNIT IN THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT.

(B) EXCEPTIONS.

THIS TITLE DOES NOT APPLY TO:

- (1) AN ELECTED STATE OFFICIAL;
- (2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR OR WHOSE APPOINTMENT REQUIRES THE GOVERNOR'S APPROVAL;
 - (3) THE CHIEF DEPUTY STATE COMPTROLLER;
 - (4) THE CHIEF DEPUTY STATE TREASURER;
 - (5) AN ATTORNEY IN THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL;
- (6) AN ATTORNEY IN THE OFFICE OF OR ENGAGED BY THE PUBLIC DEFENDER;
 - (7) AN EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT;
 - (8) A MARYLAND STATE POLICE OFFICER;
- (9) AN EMPLOYEE WHO IS SUBJECT TO A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT THAT CONTAINS ANOTHER GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE:
- (10) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO, AS AN INMATE OR PATIENT IN AN INSTITUTION, IS EMPLOYED BY THIS STATE;
 - (11) A STUDENT EMPLOYEE;
- (12) AN EMPLOYEE, INCLUDING A MEMBER OF A FACULTY, WHO IS SUBJECT TO A CONTRACT OR REGULATIONS GOVERNING TEACHER TENURE;
 - (13) AN EMPLOYEE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SYSTEM;
