10-201. STEPS IN GRIEVANCE PROCEEDING.

(A) STEPS IDENTIFIED.

THE THREE STEPS IN THE GRIEVANCE PROCEEDING ARE:

- (1) THE INITIATION OF A GRIEVANCE PROCEEDING;
- (2) AN APPEAL TO THE HEAD OF THE PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENT OR OTHER INDEPENDENT UNIT: AND
  - (3) AN APPEAL TO THE SECRETARY.
  - (B) BYPASSING STEPS.

THE PARTIES MAY AGREE TO BYPASS ANY STEP OF THE GRIEVANCE PROCEEDING.
