- (V) A deputy sheriff who uses [his] A personal automobile is entitled to a monthly automobile allowance at the same rate paid to other State employees. Any Sheriff who is assigned a city-owned automobile may not receive the monthly automobile expense allowance.
- (VI) [They] THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE shall also have assistants at the compensation provided for in the annual ordinance of estimates of Baltimore City. Provisions shall also be made in the ordinance for the expenses of the office of the Sheriff, including the purchase and maintenance of motor vehicles.
- (VII) The Mayor and City Council OF BALTIMORE [have] HAS the same power with respect to the salaries of the office of the Sheriff as [they have] IT HAS under the city charter with respect to the salaries of all municipal departments.
- (VIII) Employees of the Sheriff's office, except the Sheriff, shall be selected according to the provisions of [§ 9E of Article 64A of the Code] THE STATE PERSONNEL ARTICLE THAT GOVERN CLASSIFIED SERVICE EMPLOYEES.
