(E) (1) A MEMBER OF THE TOLL FACILITIES POLICE FORCE IS ENTITLED TO THE SALARY PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(2) (I) A MEMBER OF THE TOLL FACILITIES POLICE FORCE IS IN THE UNCLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE STATE PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM.

(II) HOWEVER, A MEMBER OF THE TOLL FACILITIES POLICE FORCE IS SUBJECT TO DIVISION I OF THE STATE PERSONNEL ARTICLE TO THE SAME EXTENT THAT A MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE IS SUBJECT TO THAT LAW.

(F) (1) AN AIRPORT POLICE EMPLOYEE IS IN THE UNCLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE STATE PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM.

(2) HOWEVER, AN AIRPORT POLICE EMPLOYEE IS SUBJECT TO DIVISION I OF THE STATE PERSONNEL ARTICLE TO THE SAME EXTENT THAT A MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE IS SUBJECT TO THAT LAW.
