Except as provided in §§ 3.05(a)(1)(v), (vi), and (viii), [(3)] (4), and (b), 3.06(b) [through (d)] AND (C), 4.09, 7.01(c), 10.01, 11.01, and 12.01 of this article, this article does not apply to the chartered counties of Maryland. This section supersedes § 7.02 of this article and any inconsistent provision of Article 28 of the Code.

(l) Whenever an audit of the records of a school system, public library, or educational institution reveals that the system, library, or institution owes money to the Accumulation Fund of the Teachers' Retirement System OR THE TEACHERS' PENSION SYSTEM, any delinquent payment may be collected by the State Retirement Agency in the manner set forth in §§ 5-202.1, 16-403.1, and 23-403.1 of the Education Article.
