(a) The professional and clerical employees of any library established or operating under the provisions of Title 23 of the Education Article are included in the definition of "teacher" and "member," as those terms are defined respectively in § 3-101(j) of this title and [§ 1-101(l)] § 1-101(N) of this article, and all such professional and clerical employees are entitled to all the rights and privileges and subject to all of the obligations of the Teachers' Retirement System as established and maintained under this subtitle except as provided in subsection (d) of this section; provided, however, that each professional and clerical employee of the department of public libraries of Montgomery
