

(iii) Another health professional who is qualified sufficiently by advanced training to supervise the same kind of services in a hospital; and

(6) Require submission of an annual report which includes service utilization statistics.

(d) The provisions of this section do not waive the requirement for a home health agency to obtain a certificate of need.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1993.

CHAPTER 19

(Senate Bill 289)

AN ACT concerning

Garrett County Sanitary District – Reconnection Fee for Nonpayment of Water Bills

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Sanitary Commission of Garrett County to require property owners in the County sanitary district to pay up to a certain amount to have the owner's water service reconnected after nonpayment of a water bill; and generally relating to the fee to reconnect water service in the Garrett County sanitary district.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Environment

9-662.

(1) If a water bill is unpaid for 30 days after being sent, and after written notice is left on the premises or mailed to the last known address of the owner, the sanitary commission may:

(1) Disconnect water service to the property; and

(2) Require, before reconnecting water service, payment of the entire water bill plus:
