- (a) (1) This subsection does not apply to the wages of an employee holding [a temporary pending,] AN emergency [,] or temporary extra position under [\S 4-306,] \S 12-101 [,] or \S 12-102 of this article.
- (b) Subject to the approval of the Governor, the Secretary may adopt regulations that prohibit a State officer from paying [a classified service] AN employee IN THE STATE PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM any wages unless:
 - (1) the officer has a payroll authorization from the Secretary that lists:
 - (i) the name of that employee;
 - (ii) the amount to be paid to that employee; and
 - (iii) the services for which payment is to be paid; and
- (2) the head of a principal department or other independent unit certifies in each payroll for that department or unit that the employees named in the payroll have been lawfully employed during the pay period and are entitled to the compensation authorized by the Secretary.

- (a) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, this section applies to:
- (i) all employees, including [appointed officials and] classified, unclassified, full-time, part-time, permanent, temporary, and contractual employees, of all units in the executive branch of State government; and
 - (ii) all classified service employees of the District Court of Maryland.
