## (b) (1) The Program:

(i) SUBJECT TO THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER § 8-103 OF THIS SUBTITLE, SHALL ENCOMPASS ALL UNITS IN THE EXECUTIVE, JUDICIAL, AND LEGISLATIVE BRANCHES OF STATE GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING ANY UNIT WITH AN INDEPENDENT PERSONNEL SYSTEM;

(ii) shall include the health insurance benefit options established by the Secretary; and

[(ii)](iii) except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, may include any other benefit option that the Secretary considers appropriate.

(c) The Secretary shall specify by regulation the types or categories of STATE employees who:

- (1) are eligible to enroll and participate in the Program with State subsidies;
- (2) are eligible to enroll and participate in the Program without State subsidies; and
- (3) are not eligible to enroll or participate in the Program.

8-202.

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this subtitle applies to all EMPLOYEES, INCLUDING classified [service], unclassified [service], FULL-TIME, PART-TIME, PERMANENT, TEMPORARY, and contractual employees, of [any unit] ALL UNITS in the executive branch of State government, including any unit with independent pay-setting authority.

(b) There is an innovative idea [award] AWARDS program for employees.

(a) (2) Regulations to implement the innovative idea [award] AWARDS program shall be made with the concurrence of the Governor's Award Panel.
