The Director shall—receive such salary and have such deputies, assistants, employees, and professional consultants as provided in the State budget.

(c) Any personnel of the local support enforcement office involved in a transfer under this section shall become classified SERVICE employees of this State [subject to the provisions of the State Merit System Law] and shall be placed in the position that is comparable to or most closely compares to their former position, without further examination or qualification. These employees shall be credited with the years of service with the jurisdiction for the purpose of determining leave accumulation and shall become members of the State Employees' Pension System. All previous pension contributions shall be transferred in accordance with Article 73B of the Code. These employees shall receive no diminution in compensation or accumulated leave solely as a result of the transfer. Annual leave in excess of that which may be retained annually in the State Merit PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT System may be retained at the time of transfer if that accumulation was permitted by the former employer.

Article - Financial Institutions
