- (a) (2) The Deputy Commissioner IS IN THE UNCLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE STATE PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM AND serves at the pleasure of the Commissioner.
- (b) (2) The Assistant Commissioner IS IN THE UNCLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE STATE PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM AND serves at the pleasure of the Commissioner.
 - (c) (2) The Chief Elevator Inspector:
- (ii) is subject to the [Merit System Law] PROVISIONS OF THE STATE PERSONNEL ARTICLE THAT GOVERN CLASSIFIED SERVICE EMPLOYEES.
