- (h) (3) A youth recruited for the Corps may not be hired through [State merit system mechanisms FOR THE EMPLOYMENT OF CLASSIFIED SERVICE EMPLOYEES IN THE STATE PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM and may not earn any of the benefits of [a' merit system] A CLASSIFIED SERVICE employee.
- The Administration shall be adequately staffed and organized to carry out the provisions of this title and at salaries provided in the State budget.
