- (i) (1) In Washington County the fees for dogs shall be determined by the County Commissioners of the county.
- (2) (I) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY MAY PROVIDE BY ORDINANCE THAT A DOG LICENSE SHALL EXPIRE WHEN A RABIES VACCINATION CERTIFICATION ISSUED UNDER § 18–319(A)(3) OF THE HEALTH GENERAL ARTICLE EXPIRES.
- (II) IF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ALTER THE DATE ON WHICH DOG LICENSES EXPIRE, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY PROVIDE THAT THE FEE FOR A DOG LICENSE OR THE TERM OF A LICENSE SHALL BE PRORATED TO REFLECT ALTERED LICENSE TERMS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1993.

AN ACT concerning

Queen Anne's County Treasurer - Minimum Compensation - Repeal
