[(b)] ~~(C)~~ (D) A Class 4 manufacturer's licensee may sell wine on Sundays, in a sealed package or [container] CONTAINER, which may not be opened or the contents consumed on the licensee's premises, subject to the other restrictions contained in § 5(e)(1).

[(c)] ~~(D)~~ (E) (1) A Class A wine licensee may sell wine on Sundays.

(2) (i) [In Frederick County the] THE board of license commissioners may grant a special Sunday opening permit to a Class A beer, wine and liquor (off-sale) licensee.

(ii) The special Sunday opening permit authorizes the holder to sell beer, wine and liquor for off-premises consumption on Sundays from 1 p.m. to 12 o'clock midnight.

(iii) The annual fee for the special Sunday-opening permit is \$650 in addition to the annual fee for the Class A beer, wine and liquor (off-sale) license.

(iv) The special Sunday opening permit is not considered a separate class of license and, if it is granted, the privilege shall be incorporated into the existing Class A beer, wine and liquor license.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1993.
