

sales for consumption [anywhere except] on the premises on which meals are prepared and served, except in the case of [consumption of] beverages with an alcoholic content of not more than [12] 14.5 percent by volume, WHICH MAY BE SOLD FOR OFF-PREMISES CONSUMPTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1993.

**CHAPTER 49**

**(House Bill 597)**

AN ACT concerning

**Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages**

**(Special Event Collectible Bottles)**

FOR the purpose of authorizing in Frederick County the sale of special anniversary/special event collectible bottles of wine and liquor under certain circumstances; clarifying language and structure; directing that a certain clarification of structure occur; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Frederick County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**
