(b) Constables may serve either full time or part time. Full-time constables are in the classified service of the State Personnel Management System and shall be paid on the same salary scale as that set by the Secretary of Personnel pursuant to § 2–309(d) of this article for full-time deputy sheriffs in Baltimore City. Part-time constables are not in the State Personnel Management System, and are paid the compensation prescribed by the General Assembly, and serve at the pleasure of the Chief Judge of the District Court.
