(b) Competitive sealed proposals may be used if:

(3) The board [or] OF trustees or its designee determines that:

(i) The need to use a method other than competitive sealed bids is sufficiently compelling to override the general public policy that favors awarding procurement contracts on the basis of competitive sealed bids; and

(ii) The use of competitive sealed bidding for that procurement contract is not practicable or not advantageous to the college.

(a) (4) "Health occupation" means a:

(i) Physical therapist or a physical therapist assistant who has at least an Associate [of Arts] degree in physical therapy;

(ii) Occupational therapist or an occupational therapist assistant who has at least an Associate [of Arts] degree in occupational therapy;
