 - [(2)] (II) 2 members of the Senate, appointed by the President;
 - [(3) 1 member designated by the United States Coast Guard;] and
 - [(4)] (III) [11] 12 members appointed by the Governor, as follows:
- [(i)] 1. The Secretary of Natural Resources, or the Secretary's designee;
- [(ii)] 2. 2 members representing the Maryland Association of Counties;
 - [(iii)] 3. The Director of the Maryland Historical Trust;
- [(iv)] 4. 2 members representing the Maryland Congressional Delegation;
 - [(v)] 5. 1 member representing the Maryland Municipal League;
- [(vi)] 6. 2 members representing the Maryland Watermen's Association; [and]
- 7. 1 MEMBER REPRESENTING THE ASSOCIATION OF MARYLAND PILOTS; AND
 - [(vii)] 8. 2 members of the general public.
- (2) A MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD MAY SERVE AS A TECHNICAL ADVISOR TO THE COMMISSION.
