## Article 22 - Washington County

6-101.

- (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) "Allocation fee" means the charge for being connected to a water or sewerage system, including, but not limited to, an initial connection charge.
- (c) "Clerk" means the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Washington County, Maryland.
- (d) "Commission" means the governing body of the District, the Washington County Sanitary Commission.
- (e) "County" means the political subdivision of this State known as the County Commissioners of Washington County, and where appropriate to the context, its elected Board of County Commissioners.
- (f) "District" means the body politic and corporate created under this title, the Washington County Sanitary District.
- (g) "Drainage system" means the inlet, outfall lines, equipment, and property for the carrying off and disposal of surface waters.
- (h) "Project" means a water system, sewerage system, or drainage system or any part of these systems that the District owns, constructs, or operates.
  - (i) "Property" means any interest in real estate.
- (j) "Regulation" means the policies that have been formally adopted and published by the Commission.
- (k) [(1) "Representation area" means an area comprised of one or more subdistricts, not necessarily contiguous, but located in the same general geographic area.
