(f) (1) A contract or certificate issued to a member or subscriber by a health maintenance organization that provides health care benefits and services for diseases may not discriminate against any person with a mental illness by failing to provide health care benefits and services for treatment and diagnosis of mental illness that the Commissioner determines are generally available under §§ 354 and 490V of Article 48A of the Code.
