(c) (3) State employees who transfer to the Service's new personnel system shall, unless fairly compensated for the leave by the Service, retain vacation leave, sick leave, and personal and compensatory leave earned prior to the date of transfer until the time that the leave would normally expire under the regulations [of Article 64A of the Code] ADOPTED UNDER THE STATE PERSONNEL AND PENSIONS ARTICLE.

(5) Classified State employees who elect not to transfer to the new personnel system shall retain all rights and privileges of the State [Merit] PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT System until January 1, 1995.

(6) State employees who are not classified in the State [Merit] PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT System who elect not to transfer to the new personnel system shall retain such rights and privileges as existed on July 1, 1993, until January 1, 1995.

Error: Obsolete cross-reference and terminology in § 13-103.1(c)(3), (5), and (6) of the Natural Resources Article.

Occurred: As a result of Ch. 10, Acts of 1993, which enacted Division I of the State Personnel and Pensions Article.

4-402.

The title to any area of water or land acquired by purchase, gift, or condemnation shall be taken in the name of the State for the Department's use. The entire control of the area of water or land shall be under the State's direction. The Secretary may expend from the State Fisheries Management and Protection Fund any amount necessary to purchase or condemn [as] AN area of water or land.
