

Article 83B – Department of Housing and Community Development

[6-205.

(a) In carrying out his duties under this subtitle, the Secretary shall have the assistance of an Advisory Commission on Industrialized Building and Mobile Homes, which is hereby created. Members of the Advisory Commission shall be appointed by the Secretary and shall serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred while engaged in the performance of their duties in accordance with the Standard Travel Regulations. Members appointed shall be broadly representative of the industries and professions involved in the development and construction of industrialized buildings and mobile homes and shall also include representatives from building code enforcement agencies, architectural and engineering associations, building construction trades, the contracting and manufacturing industries, legislative bodies of local government, the financial industry and the general public.

(b) The Advisory Commission shall make recommendations to the Secretary regarding the rules and regulations as promulgated under this subtitle as it shall from time to time deem necessary or desirable. The Advisory Commission shall submit an annual report to the Secretary and, subject to § 2-1312 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly regarding rules, regulations, and programs relating to this subtitle.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1994.

CHAPTER 127

(Senate Bill 89)

AN ACT concerning

Department of Housing and Community Development – Partnership Rental Housing Program
