SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21-305.

(a) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, a person may not operate a food establishment unless the person is licensed by the Department.

21-309.

- (b) (1) Except as provided in Title 10, Subtitle 4 of the State Government Article and in [paragraphs (2), (3), and (4)] PARAGRAPH (2) of this subsection, and unless it is renewed for another term, a license expires 1 year from the date of issuance or renewal or as provided by local law, ordinance, or regulation in accordance with § 21–304(b) and (c) of this subtitle.
- [(2) Except as provided in Title 10, Subtitle 4 of the State Government Article, and unless it is renewed for another term, a license to operate a crab meat plant expires on April 1 of each year.
