- (2) If an applicant has completed 1 or more years of a college or university curriculum in engineering that the Board approves, it may allow, for each of those years, a 1-year credit towards the experience requirement of paragraph (1)(i) of this subsection.
- (3) IF AN APPLICANT HAS COMPLETED 1 OR MORE YEARS OF A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY CURRICULUM IN ENGINEERING THAT HAS NOT BEEN APPROVED BY THE BOARD, THE BOARD MAY ALLOW, FOR EACH OF THOSE YEARS, A 6-MONTH CREDIT OF UP TO 6 MONTHS TOWARDS THE EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENT UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(I) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1994.
