Labor and Industry of the Department of Licensing and Regulation, and the Public Service Commission shall include a discussion of their efforts to promote these policies in their respective annual reports as required by law.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 10–207(g) through (s), respectively, of Article – Tax – General of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 10–207(f) through (r), respectively.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1994.
