- (c) As to any [Type I] school vehicle, whenever the vehicle is not being operated on a highway for the transportation of children, students, or teachers for educational purposes or in connection with a school activity:
 - (1) The alternately flashing warning lights shall be deactivated; and
- (2) The words "school bus" at the front and rear of the vehicle shall be covered or otherwise concealed [and the word "chartered" substituted].

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Business Occupations and Professions

16-315.

- (b) (1) The Commission shall approve the form, substance, and, as provided under paragraph (2) of this subsection, subject matter of all continuing education courses.
 - (2) The subject matter approved by the Commission shall:
 - (i) relate to real estate; and
- (ii) every 2 years, include at least one 3-hour course that outlines relevant changes that have occurred in federal, State, [and] OR local laws, OR ANY COMBINATION OF THOSE LAWS, during the preceding 5 years.
